

Betty DeLosh Obituary

Betty DeLosh, age 83 of Arnold, died Saturday, June 18, 2005, at the Good Samaritan Hospital in Kearney.

Services will be at 11 a.m. Wednesday, June 22, at the United Methodist Church in Arnold. Pastor Gene Purcell will officiate.

Burial will be in the Arnold Cemetery with military honors.
