

Jacqueline Geiser Scott

1929-2015

Jacqueline Imogene Geiser Scott, age 85 years and 4 months, passed away peacefully in her sleep on Sunday, April 19, 2015, from heart, kidney and lung prob-



lems at St. Luke's Hospital in Meridian, Idaho.

Jackie was the eldest daughter of Archie Delbert Geiser and Irma Lea Phifer. She was born December 13, 1929, in Arnold, Nebraska. She graduated from Arnold High School in 1949.

After high school she moved to Denver, Colorado, to work before returning to Arnold to work as a nurse at the Arnold Hospital. She married Maurice Lavern ("Scotty") Scott in Stapleton, Nebraska, on May 19, 1951. The couple moved to Ft. Sill, Oklahoma, where Maurice was in the U.S. Army. He served in the Korean War from 1951 to 1953. After the war, they moved back to Arnold, Nebraska, and had two children, Rhonda and Rodney. Jackie worked as a homemaker while the children were young.

In 1959, the family moved to San Pedro, California, where Maurice worked as a car mechanic. Later they bought their own car repair/service station business where Jackie worked doing the accounting office work. She later retired from the Los Angeles School District as an elementary school cafeteria manager.

They moved to Minden,

Nevada, after retirement, then in 2003 they moved to Boise, Idaho. Jackie was a very good bowler and joined leagues wherever she lived.

She and Maurice "Scotty" bought a motorhome and traveled across the United States and up to Alaska a few times. Jackie loved to travel and go on cruises. She visited Australia with Maurice and traveled with her daughter to many European countries, Mexico, Honduras, the Caribbean and cruised Trans-Atlantic aboard the ship Queen Elizabeth II from New York City to Southampton, England.

Jackie loved many kinds of music, especially from the 1940's, country music, Irish songs and Broadway show tunes.

She is survived by her daughter, Rhonda Scott of Boise, Idaho; her son, Rodney (Patricia) Scott and granddaughters, Hannah Scott and Abigail Scott, all of Meridian, Idaho; sisters, Geraldine (Clark) Sauer of Gladstone, Missouri; Brenda Olin of Grand Island; and Rickie (Steve) McKnight of Albuquerque, New Mexico, as well as sisters and brothers-in-law and many special nieces and

nephews.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Maurice "Scotty" Scott; her parents, Archie and Lea Phifer Geiser; her sister, Frances Geiser Scott and her brother, Robert Geiser.
