Morris Eugene Joy 1946-2015

Morris Eugene Joy, 68, passed away August 2, 2015, at Great Plains Regional Medical Center in North Platte, Nebraska. Morris was born September 6, 1946, to Vernon and Sophia Morris Joy in Arnold, Nebraska. He was raised in the Arnold area. He attended school in the Stone school west of Arnold for two years, then attended Logan District 4 School through March of 1957. He completed elementary and high school at Arnold, graduating in 1964. Following graduation, he attended Grand Island School of Business one year, receiving a degree in accounting.

In February, 1966, Morris joined the Navy, serving in Vietnam and Japan where he received a Bronze Star. Upon his discharge from the Navy in September, 1970, he returned to Arnold where he worked for several farmers and the Village of Arnold for many years.

He was preceded in death by his parents and one brother-in-law, Dennis Wing.
