

Amos O. Alexander, 79, Arnold Pioneer Is Buried Today

Arnold -(Special)- Funeral services were held at 2 p. m. today for Amos O. Alexander, Arnold-Broken Bow resident since 1890, who died in Broken Bow Tuesday.
