

CHARLES F. McGUIRE

CHARLES F. McGUIRE was born to John Henry and Anna McGuire in the Powell Canyon near Arnold, Custer County, Nebraska, on September 6, 1885, and he passed away on July 6, 1969 at Wilcox, Arizona, at the age of 83 years and 10 months. He died on Sunday at Wilcox.

He was married on June 22, 1910 to Blanche R. Allen, and to this union were born four children.

He attended Kearney State Teachers College in Kearney, Nebraska for two years. He was engaged in the pharmacy business for two years, and he was the Postmaster in Arnold, Nebraska for 2 years.

He then went back to farming about 1914, and he was engaged then in farming and in the auctioneer business most of the remainder of his life. In 1960, he moved to Wilcox, Arizona, and in 1967 he moved to Safford, Arizona.

Charlie was a member of the Masonic Lodge No. 225 of Arnold, Nebraska, and he had been very active in his earlier years in the Methodist Church.

He is survived by his wife, Blanche Allen McGuire, by one daughter, Mrs. Gerald W. Miller of Arcadia, California, and by three sons, Edgar McGuire of Wilcox, Arizona, and William and Charles McGuire, both of Santa Clara, California; by 10 grandchildren; also by 3 sisters, Bessie Marrs of Longmont, Colorado, Millie Hill of Beaverton, Oregon, and Alice Millikin of McMinville, Oregon, and by many other relatives and by many friends.

Funeral services were held for Mr. McGuire on Friday, July 11, 1969 at 10:30 a.m. in the United Methodist Church in Arnold, Nebraska, with Rev. Stanley Schrag, pastor, officiating. Mr. and Mrs. Don Swanson sang "The Old Rugged Cross" and "In the Garden," accompanied by Mrs. Charles D. Quig. Mrs. Mynor Smith was the organist for the services.

Pallbearers were Floyd Lucas, David Mills, George Halstead, Lowell Watkins, Charles Blowers and Louis Halstead. Interment was made in the cemetery at Arnold, Custer County, Nebraska, with the Cable Lodge No. 225 A.F. & A.M. in Arnold assisting with the graveside services. The O. D. Quig Funeral Home of Arnold was in charge of the arrangements.
