

Mrs. Lovira Allen, 95, Dies Wednesday; Had Homesteaded Arnold

Mrs. Lovira Allen, 95, who with her husband, the late R. E. Allen, platted the town of Arnold on land they had homesteaded in May, 1880, died Wednesday morning, April 15, two weeks after she had fallen in her home and broken a hip.

Mrs. Allen was born November 11, 1857, near Cedar Rapids, Iowa.

She is survived by three daughters, Mrs. Gertrude McCants and Mrs. Charles McGuire of Arnold, and Mrs. Myrtle Chadima of Cedar Rapids, Iowa.

Funeral services are planned for Saturday, April 18, at 2 o'clock from the Methodist church, with Rev. E. N. Littrell and the O.E.S. Lodge in charge of the services.
