

Services Held For David Lewis Andre

Funeral services were held on Thursday, October 5 at 2 o'clock P.M., from the Arnold Baptist Church for David Lewis Andre, who died on Monday, October 2 after a long illness.

Rev. B. D. Hunn of North Platte officiated at the services.

Rev. and Mrs. Forrest Woodman sang "Standing Somewhere In The Shadows" and "In The Garden" accompanied by Mrs. Jerald Harter as pianist.

All his life was spent around Arnold with the exception of one year at North Platte.

He was converted in the Baptist Church at North Platte in 1915.

He was united in marriage to Annie Corfield in North Platte on August 10, 1915 and to this union two sons were born: Lewis Frank and Clarence John.

He was preceded in death by his parents; one brother and one sister.
