

**FUNERAL SERVICES TODAY
AT STAPLETON FOR
JAMES CLARK ANDRE**

James Clark Andre, former long time resident of the Garfield community, passed away early Monday morning at a North Platte hospital, at the age of 81 years.

Funeral services will be held Thursday, July 19th, at 2:00 p. m. at the First Presbyterian Church in Stapleton with the Rev. Edward Holub and the Rev. Maurice Holt officiating.

Mr. Andre was born in Pennsylvania in 1880 and had lived in Lincoln and Logan counties since 1883, having come to Nebraska at that time with his parents. He had spent the past two years at North Platte, Nebraska.

He was a member of the Gandy Independent Order Of Odd Fellows for 38 years and was also a member of the Methodist Church and Rebekah Lodge at Gandy; the Encampment Lodge of North Platte; the Patriarch Militant and NEA Lodges of Cozad.
