

Robert Aydelotte Killed On Tuesday

Funeral services will be held this Friday, April 22 from the Arnold Methodist Church, for Robert Aydelotte, 65, who died on Tuesday, April 22 from a tractor accident.

Mr. Aydelotte was harrowing a terrace near his farm home west of Arnold about 4:00 P. M., on Tuesday afternoon, when the tractor went over backwards as it was going over a terrace, killing Mr. Aydelotte instantly.

He was alone at the time and was discovered by Raymond Foran, who was working nearby, when he noticed the tractor upside down.

Services will be held at 2:00 P.M., with Rev. Harold Massie in charge.

Burial will be at Arnold.

He was born on July 23, 1894 at Fullerton, Nebr.

Mr. Aydelotte is survived by his wife, Ruth; three sons: Robert Roy, James Frank and Ralph Lee all at home; three sisters: Margaret Aydelotte of Arnold, Mrs. Alice Giles of Mullen and Mrs. Georgia Holden of Alamide, California; and a brother, Farquar of Martin, Wyoming.
