

Andrew J. McCants Rites To Be In Arnold Thursday

Arnold — Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Thursday at the Quig funeral home chapel in Arnold for Andrew J. McCants, who died Monday at the age of 78 years, eight months and two days.

McCants, a resident of the Arnold community since 1888, was retired. He was born Nov. 1, 1871, at Butler, Mo.
