

## Child Dies from Rattlesnake Bite.

Little Charles Kelly, the two year old son of Mr. and Mrs. John Kelly, who reside north of this place, was the first person in this locality for some time to be bitten by a rattlesnake. With other children of the family the little boy was playing close by the house and while making mud balls he was bitten on the index finger by a rattler which was killed and found to have five rattles. It being some distance to the nearest phone from which Dr. Robertson was called, about an hour elapsed before medical aid could reach him. In the meantime Mrs. Kelley knowing of nothing else to do, bound the arm above the wound. The doctor lanced the wound, but was unable to start a flow of blood and every other treatment known to his profession was applied, but the child's system was so affected with the venom before treatment began that medical skill availed little and death came to relieve him of terrible suffering at four o'clock Sunday morning, just twelve hours after he was bitten. Funeral services were held Monday by Rev. Fagan and interment was made in Powell canyon cemetery. The grief stricken parents and family has the heartfelt sympathy of the entire community in their sudden bereavement.—Arnold Sentinel.
