

## **ELMER JUNE PASSES TO HIS REWARD AFTER LONG ILLNESS**

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After suffering from Brights disease and other complications for several months, Elmer June passed away at the home of Lester Lewis Monday morning, May 23, 1927, and following will be found an obituary of his life:

### **OBITUARY**

Elmer Scott June, son of Isaac and Nance June, was born August 26th, 1869, at Toledo, Ohio. His mother died when he was 11 years old. At the age of about 14 years he and his father came to Fremont, Nebraska, and a short time later they came to this part of the state, where he has since resided. He took a homestead in Logan County, proving up on some. His father died November 29, 1904 at the age of 59 years, 3 months and 2 days. On November 27, 1912 he was united in marriage to Ethel Harmon, and to this union was born one son, Elmer Gerald June.

Mr. June has enjoyed very good health until the past winter when a decline was noted. Several weeks ago, he became bedfast and his condition was so weakened that medical science could do nothing for him, and on the morning of May 23, 1927, he passed on to his Eternal reward at the age of 57 years, 9 months and 3 days.

Elmer, as he was commonly known, had many friends, and through much of his illness, he was cared for by the various fraternal orders of Arnold, although not a member of any.

He leaves a son, two sisters, one half-brother, Oscar June of Arnold, also three half-sisters, Myrtle Lown of Cartage, Missouri, Minnie McKennon of Colon, Nebraska and Minnie Sams of Arnold.

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
