

EVERETT SHUCK BURIED IN FOWELL CANYON CEMETERY.

Youngest Son of Mr. and Mrs. Wm. Shuck Now of Elba.

The noon train of Wednesday March 23, brought in the remains of Everett Shuck, son of Mr. and Mrs. William Shuck, pioneer settlers of this part of the county. Earl was the youngest son, and died after an attack of what appeared to be typhoid fever.

Mr. and Mrs. Shuck will be remembered by all old timers, they having settled in the community northeast of Arnold in the year of 1881, where they proved up on their homestead, and with the exception of a couple of years they resided here for a period of thirty-two years, removing to Elba, in Howard county about six years ago where they resided at the time of the death of Everett.

The family and remains were met at the depot by old friends and neighbors, who comforted and assisted the bereaved ones in every way possible. Burial was made in the family lot where two sons and the mother of Mr. Shuck await the resurrection.
