

Gerald Brooks Funeral Services Held at 2:00, Friday, July 26

Funeral services for Gerald W Brooks, 27, of Ainsworth, son of Mrs Fern Brooks of Arnold, who was killed Monday July 22 when a tractor overturned on him, were held from the Jensen Funeral Home in Ainsworth at 10:00 A M, on Thursday, July 25 and from the Quig Funeral Home in Arnold at 2 o'clock on Friday, July 26.

Rev O S Hemseltine was in charge of the services at Ainsworth, while Morris Powell, minister of the Church of Christ was in charge of services in Arnold.

Burial was in the Powell Canyon cemetery.

Gerald Wayne Brooks, son of Frederick and Fern Brooks, was born at Arnold, Nebraska October 19, 1918, and passed away at Ainsworth, Nebraska on July 22, 1946 at the age of 27 years, 9 months and 3 days.

He spent his life in and around Arnold, Nebraska until three years ago when he came to Ainsworth to make his home.

On October 9, 1944 he was united in marriage to Alma Bejot.

His father, two sisters and two brothers preceded him in death.
