

Warren Copeland, 82, Dies Sunday; Funeral Wednesday

Warren D. Copeland, 82, died Sunday, March 1, at the Arnold Hospital. He had been in failing health for a number of months, and entered the hospital about two weeks ago.

Services were held Wednesday afternoon at two o'clock at the Methodist Church, with Rev. E. N. Littrell in charge. Mrs. Lonnie Swisher and Reverend Littrell sang during the services, accompanied by Mrs. John Dennis.

Pallbearers were George Brooks, Luman and Cecil Wonch, and Orval, Elgin and Everett Chesley. Interment was in the Powell Canyon cemetery.

Warren Denslow Copeland, son of Jared and Dimmia Copeland, was born in New York State on October 16, 1852. While a child, he moved with his parents to Michigan, and later to Osborn county, Kansas. In 1888, he came to Arnold, taking a homestead in Powell Canyon.

On July 2, 1899, he was married to Lucy Jane Chesley Walker, who preceded him in death on May 26, 1940.

Mr. Copeland united with the Christian Church over 40 years ago and was an active member as long as his health would permit.

He is survived by one brother, Jared J. Copeland of Arnold, two step-sons, Lynn C. Walker of Arnold and Keith G. Walker of Dix, and a number of nieces and nephews.
