

**FORMER RESIDENT OF THIS VI-
CINITY BURIED HERE.**

William Shuck, who formerly resided in these parts for many years, passed away at his home in Grand Island last Wednesday and was interred in the Powell Canyon cemetery Saturday afternoon.

Mr. Shuck came to this community in the early nineties with his family and settled near Loyal making this their home until 1913 when they removed to Elba, later going to live a Grand Island where he lived until his death.

OBITUARY.

Wm. M. B. Shuck was born in Gordon, Ind., October 4, 1848, and departed this life in Grand Island, Wednesday, April 9, 1930, aged 81 years, 6 months and 5 days. He came to Arnold (Loyal) in 1893, moved to Elba in 1913 and to Grand Island four years ago.

His preference was always for the Baptist church. His last illness lasted for about six weeks.

Besides his immediate family he leaves a host of friends who will miss him very much.
