

"Uncle Jack" Dillon Passed Away; Had Reached Age Of 83

John Fremont Dillon was born September 25, 1856, in Wabash county, Illinois, and passed away Monday, June 17, 1940, at the age of eighty-three years and eight months.

He came with his parents to Otoe county, Nebraska, when six months old. For about forty years he made his home on Garfield Table with his niece, Mrs. Stella M. Smith, later residing with his niece-in-law, Mrs. Minnie Dillon.

Five brothers and one sister preceded him in death and the only remaining relatives he had were several nieces and nephews, among whom are Mrs. Seymour Smith of Callaway, George Dillon of York, and Mrs. Stella M. Smith of Arnold; also a number of great nieces and nephews.

Funeral services were held Wednesday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock at the home of Mrs. Stella M. Smith with Rev. Earl Geer of Gandy in charge. Rev. and Mrs. Geer, accompanied by Mrs. Mynor Smith, sang several beautiful hymns. It was a personal request of "Uncle Jack," as he was familiarly known, that there be no flowers at his funeral services. Pallbearers were Loren Dillon, Harry Dillon, Clark Smith, Robert Stockall, Mynor Smith and Art Flint. Interment was in the Arnold cemetery.
