Arnold, NE – Edward Tullis age 42, of Arnold, Nebraska, passed away April 29, 2025, at his home in Arnold.

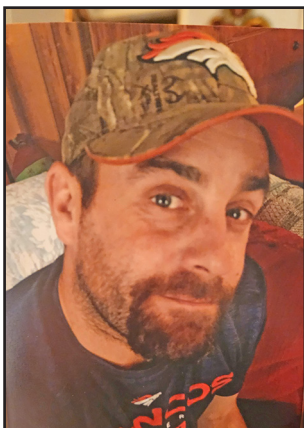
