INTERMENTS REGULATIONS

Any and all interments or burial proceedings or cremations must contact and have approval from the Arnold Cemetery Board and must proceed with permission and direction as prescribed by the Arnold Cemetery Board.

Private homemade vaults, concrete dome monument grave covers and above ground tombs will not be allowed nor will stack burials. Cremations require their own plot and can not share space with any other burial/plot space.

The Arnold Cemetery Board is hereby authorized to regulate the placing of markers, and memorials in the cemeteries operated by the township, and is hereby authorized to prohibit in areas of each cemetery designated by the arnold cemetery board all but specific types and kinds of markers, memorials and stones, as shall be deemed most appropriate by the arnold cemetery board.

PLACING OF STONES

Any person or persons wishing to place markers must contact the Arnold Cemetery Board 48 hours in advance to insure proper location and placement. placing of stones requires an official marking prior to placement by the Arnold Cemetery Board. Each space is an area surveyed and measured by an appointed surveyor. mapping for spaces, are online, on the plat and in the book. Foot stones are not allowed. No stones, monuments, markers, etc. will be placed in such a manner as to block the view of other spaces or to cause removal to allow digging of another grave.

SALE AND CARE OF SPACES

Permission must be given by written order of any owner of vacant burial spaces for the interment therein for other than any immediate members of the family provided it be not for profit.

Arnold Cemetery Board and Arnold Township Board will not be held responsible for any injury or damage done to gravestones, objects, items, markers, structures, or memorials on burial spaces or by any contractor, or workman engaged in work upon spaces and for the removal of any rubbish that may be left in doing the work, and for charges for work done by the cemetery.

Space owners will be held responsible for any injury or damage done either to the grounds or cemetery or that of any other space owner, by any contractor, or workman engaged in work upon their spaces and for the removal of any rubbish that may be left in doing the work, and for charges for work done by the cemetery.

All excavations for vaults or foundations or monuments, digging of graves or any other work must be done under the supervision of the Arnold Cemetery Board. All charges shall be billed and collected in a timely manner and are the responsibility of burial space owners.

A restriction of spaces is limited to six spaces for each purchaser. Each case is subject to review by the Arnold Cemetery Board,

CEMETERY AND LOT REGULATIONS

The following rules and regulations shall be observed and enforced so far as practicable by the Arnold Cemetery Board and owners.

When you purchase a plot, you are buying the right to inter (bury) a person in that space, not the land itself. Cemetery plot ownership law dictates that the cemetery remains the actual owner of the land. Your use of the plot is subject to the rules and regulations that govern the cemetery.

Flowers and grave decorations must be removed by June 10th or they may be discarded.

Flowers and grave decorations not on the headstone or tomb and placed on the ground except for memorial day shall impede and impair groundskeeping. Arnold Cemetery Board is not responsible for damages or upkeep due to any hindrances due to improper placement of decorations.

No trees shall be planted, removed, cut down or destroyed within or outside of the borders of any lots without consent of the Arnold Cemetery Board.

The Arnold Cemetery Board shall have the right to remove from any lot any trees or shrubs that may be detrimental to any adjacent lot or avenues or which in their judgement may mar any.

No hedges, coping or curbing or enclosure of any kind allowed around the lots.

No pleasure or picnic parties will be permitted on the grounds.

No person will be permitted to destroy the flowers, plants, shrubbery or trees within the grounds or in any way to deface or injure monuments or gravestones.

All persons disturbing the quiet and good order of the cemetery by noise or other improper conduct shall be summarily removed from the grounds and held amenable to the law.

Persons engaged in erecting memorials or other structures are prohibited from attaching ropes to trees or shrubs, and from scattering their material over adjoining lots or leaving the same on the grounds longer than necessary.

The Arnold Cemetery Board is hereby authorized to make rules and regulations respecting the days of the week and the hours of day in which interments and funerals shall be permitted in cemeteries operated by the Arnold Township.

The Arnold Cemetery Board is hereby authorized to make all rules and regulations in which the board deemed necessary or expedient to exercise properly, the lawful powers and functions of such Arnold Cemetery Board for the proper management and operation of the cemeteries operated by the township.

Arnold Cemetery Board reserves the right to reclaim unused plots under Nebraska Revised Statutes Chapter 12, Cemeteries section 12-505.

The Arnold Cemetery Board serves at the direction of Arnold Township and is not liable for damages to any structures, markers, grave memorials, or personal property.
